

**HUMBOLDT LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN the Humboldt Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) will conduct public hearings on Wednesday, September 16, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in the Supervisors Chamber of the Humboldt County Courthouse, 825 Fifth Street, Eureka, California, to consider the following:

1) Annexation of 2212 Jacoby Creek Road to the City of Arcata

The Commission will consider a proposal for annexation of approximately 1.04 acres of land at 2212 Jacoby Creek Road (APN 511-011-006), generally located northeast of the intersection of Old Arcata Road and Jacoby Creek Road. The annexation request is a result of extension of services (City Sewer) outside the City boundary based on public and environmental health and safety concerns from documented failure of the on-site wastewater system.

2) Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation of the Sunny Brae Forest Management Unit/Davis Property to the City of Arcata

The Commission will consider a proposal for a sphere of influence amendment consisting of 386 acres and a corresponding annexation of 325 acres (10 parcels) of primarily City-owned undeveloped forestland known as the Sunny Brae Forest Management Unit (SBFMU) to be managed as part of the Arcata Community Forest. The annexation also includes provision of City water and wastewater services to a fully-developed residential parcel (APN 500-132-001) adjacent to the SBFMU properties.

3) Countywide Recreation and Park Services Municipal Service Review (continued from July 15th meeting)

The Commission will consider adopting a draft Countywide Recreation and Park Services Municipal Service Review and approving report recommendations, including updating the spheres of influence for the Northern Humboldt and the Rohnerville Community Recreation and Park Districts.

All interested persons have a right to attend the public hearing and to be heard regarding the listed actions. Pursuant to state law, only issues raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the Commission at or prior to the public hearing may be raised in any legal challenge to Commission actions.
